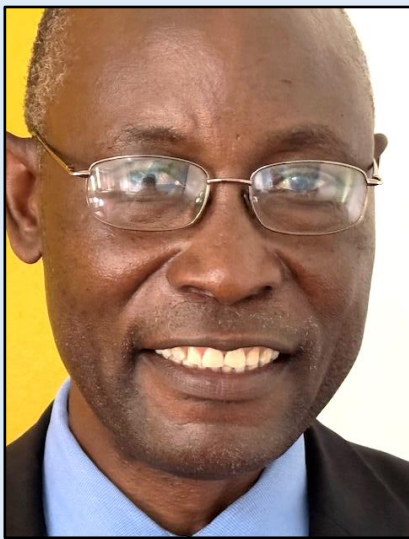

IMPACT STORY

Josephat Hamoonga



During his lifetime, JOSEPHAT HAMOONGA, has pastored more churches than most! Saved at 24, Hamoonga came to Christ after experiencing two frightening dreams. In the first dream, many Christians were taken to heaven, but Hamoonga was left behind. In the second, Hamoonga died, but when Christ returned, he did not resurrect with the other Christians. Both dreams shook Hamoonga to his core & he gave his life to Christ. After serving two years in literature evangelism, Hamoonga became a circuit pastor, overseeing multiple churches at the same time within a district. Over eleven years he provided spiritual leadership to five districts; training lay-leaders in a combined total of 113 churches. The largest district had 43 churches which Hamoonga was responsible for at one time. He later was appointed as a national Director, overseeing all the churches in his denomination within Zambia. "My passion" says Hamoonga, "is to share the gospel, win souls, train lay-leaders in evangelism & nurture them to take the gospel to unreached areas of Zambia". His PhD in Missiology from CCM has increased his desire to know God and participate more in His mission. Though Hamoonga is now officially "retired", he remains busy in service to Christ. Though once frightened about his own eternal destiny, Hamoonga has since led many others to salvation and meaningful service to Christ.
