Guerdibaye Didjaye



GUERDIBAYE DIDJAYE has become a better leader in his home, church and community through his studies at CCM. A native of Chad, Didjaye lives in a dry and thirsty land where 95% of the people are unreached with the gospel. He labors as a church planter; helps Sudanese refugees; feeds, clothes & educates needy children; & teaches Christian education to secondary school students. "CCM has helped me to be a better husband, father and church worker", says Didjaye, "and I am now able to interpret Scripture, evangelize, disciple believers and promote missions among my people – things that are not commonly understood, taught or practiced here." Didjaye dreams of planting a Christian school so the children of Chad can have quality education and a better future. He also wants to partner with CCM University to establish a theological school to equip workers to improve the spiritual, social and economic conditions of his country. An apostle of love, Didjaye weeps for the lost among him, helps refugees and needy children from his limited personal resources, and labours tirelessly for a mature church that will reach his nation and other nations for Christ. Training at CCM has helped Didjaye to become a leader-of-leaders among his people & slowly Chadians are receiving hope & help through the services he renders.
